Cookie Policy

Information about cookies, local storage and similar technologies used on the ASTONESA website

Operator: CFSTREAM TRADING, SAS with share capital of EUR 40,000
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Non-essential cookies and similar technologies should not be activated before valid consent where consent is required by applicable law. The Site’s cookie banner/settings tool should be configured to reflect the technologies actually deployed at launch.

1. What This Policy Covers

This Cookie Policy explains how CFSTREAM TRADING, operating the ASTONESA trademark, uses cookies and similar technologies on the ASTONESA website (the “Site”). It should be read together with the ASTONESA Privacy Policy.

2. What Cookies Are

Cookies are small text files or similar identifiers stored on or read from a device when a website is visited. Related technologies may include local storage, pixels, tags, software development kits and server-side identifiers. These technologies can support basic functionality, security, preferences, audience measurement and, where enabled, marketing.

3. Categories We May Use

Category	Purpose
Strictly necessary	Required for core Site operation, security, fraud prevention, load balancing, session management, consent recording or access to authenticated areas. These technologies generally do not require consent where they are strictly necessary for a service you request.
Preferences / functionality	Remember choices such as language, display preferences or project settings. Consent requirements depend on the specific function and applicable law.
Analytics / audience measurement	Help us understand how visitors use the Site, diagnose performance issues and improve content. Where the exemption conditions for consent are not met, these technologies are activated only after consent.
Embedded media / social features	Enable third-party video, maps, social feeds or similar content. Third parties may receive device or usage data. These are blocked pending consent where required.
Advertising / remarketing	Measure campaigns, build audiences or personalise advertising. If used, they are activated only after the consent required by applicable law.

4. Current Cookie Inventory

The exact cookies and similar technologies used may change as the Site evolves. The Site’s cookie-settings interface should display the current provider, purpose and lifespan for each non-essential technology in use. The following service types may be present depending on the Site configuration:

- hosting, security and session technologies required to deliver the Site;
- consent-management technologies used to remember your privacy choices;

- analytics tools used to measure Site usage, if enabled;
- embedded video, mapping or social-media services, if enabled;
- advertising or remarketing tools, if enabled.

Because cookie names and lifespans are technical implementation details, the deployed consent-management platform should be synchronised with the live Site so that the inventory shown to users remains accurate.

5. Consent and Your Choices

When you first visit the Site, you may be presented with a cookie banner or preference centre. Except for technologies that are strictly necessary, we seek consent before storing or accessing information on your device where required by law.

You may accept or reject optional categories and may change your choices later through the cookie-settings link or icon made available on the Site. Withdrawing consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing that occurred before withdrawal.

6. Browser Controls

Most browsers allow you to view, delete or block cookies. Blocking all cookies may prevent parts of the Site from working correctly, including secure account areas, language preferences, quotation tools or session functions. Browser controls operate independently from the Site's consent interface.

7. Third Parties

Where optional third-party services are enabled, those providers may process data under their own privacy terms. Depending on configuration, providers may act as processors, independent controllers or joint controllers. The ASTONESA Privacy Policy provides more information about categories of recipients and international transfers.

8. Retention

Cookie lifespans should be proportionate to their purpose. Session cookies normally expire when the browser session ends. Persistent cookies remain for the period stated in the Site's cookie-settings interface, unless deleted earlier. Analytics and consent technologies should be configured in accordance with applicable GDPR/ePrivacy requirements and relevant supervisory-authority guidance.

9. Changes

We may update this Cookie Policy when technologies, providers or legal requirements change. The effective date identifies the current version. Material changes to non-essential tracking practices should also be reflected in the consent interface.
